All clothing items are available from the canteen, with some versions of pants and shorts available at Big W, Best and Less and KMart.

Classroom supplies 2017

If you are looking to get your child organised for school next year and wondering what is needed, please don't panic. Generally, we ask that students in years 3-6 bring their own stationery including pens, lead pencils, ruler, glue stick, eraser, highlighter, whiteboard marker, coloured pencils, textas and wind up crayons. We do not allow liquid paper or permanent markers at school. In addition to this, individual teachers will send home a supply list early in Term 1 with any special requirements. Students in Kindergarten to Year 2 are mostly catered for by the school. This is where your \$25 per student school contribution goes - as well as funding art and craft supplies, paper for photocopying and books for students to write in. NSW public schools are encouraged to ask parents for \$80 per student to purchase the years school supplies, so please support our school as we appreciate that \$25 (\$50 max per family) is a more reasonable request for parents.
